

Safety Precautions



Please unplug the power connection before cleaning and maintaining

Please go through the manual thoroughly before operating the water cooling fan.





Do not open the control panel or the cover of the inverter without qualified guidance.

Do not operate the control panel, or touch the power plug and the cover of the inverter with wet hands.





Do not share the plug with other equipment because of the fan's high start-up current. Please choose an over 2.0 MM (14 AWG) extension cord set for the water cooling fan. Also, the extension cord should not be over 25 m. Connect the fan with an irregular cord set could cause short-circuit.





Avoid using old extension cords or sockets. Keep the wires away from heat and fire. Do not place the wires on where man or traffic crossing to prevent wire being stepped or pulled which may cause accident.

Do not remove the earth part of the plug. Choose a right and tight socket, do not use one without earthing. For your safety, do not change the power cord or the wiring of the control panel.

This unit is not capable of and should never be used to draw: (1) flammable gases, including oil gas, fuel gas, pure oxygen, hydrogen gas, etc. (2) flammable liquid, such as gas, toluene, etc. (3) dust or crystal of under 80°C fire point, including magnesium, platinum, gun powder, etc.

If the fan does not function well, please turn off the power and check the wire, socket, and extension cord. After checking, restart the fan after a while. If the problem is not solved, please contact where you purchase the fan or contact us to arrange repair service. Do not detach or change spare parts on your own.

Please place the water cooling fan on a flat ground and step on the brake button while operating. When encounter a flood damage, please unplug the fan and move it to somewhere safe.





When not using the cooling fan for a while, please open the drain at the bottom or turn on the auto drain to let out the water. Then turn on the fan for 1-2 hour to dry the cooling pad. After drying, unplug the fan for storage.

To fill the tank manually, please turn off the fan and open the ice cube entrance to fill the water. Make sure the power is away from water to prevent accident.

Do not face the air inlet side (the cooling pad side) to any burning or smoking object, including matches, ash, cigarette, cigar, charcoal, etc. Damages or accidents caused by the preceding issue are not cover by the warranty.





While operating, do not open the cover of the inverter, the cover guard of the fan, or the cooling pad on the back; also, do not through anything to the fan to avoid accident.





The water cooling fans are heavy. Please be careful while moving the cooling fan, or it may cause man-injuries if bumping or overturning occurs.

Do not open the ice cube entrance while the fan is operating. Approaching the running fan blades would cause injuries, and could crack the blades.

While cleaning the cooling fan, do not spray water to the control panel or the cover of inverter to avoid damage.





Do not convert, disassemble, or repair the product without instruction. Damage caused by the preceding issue are not cover by the warranty. Please contact us for support.





Please do not convert or change the fan blades on your own to avoid accident.





Do not move the water cooling fan by pulling the attaching hose. This could cause fan damage.

Operating Instruction

Please follow the conditions below:



Please connect the product with AC 110V or AC 220V, 50/60 Hz, Single Phase power source. (There is a voltage instruction sticker on the product.)



The power voltage should not be 10% higher or lower than the indicated voltage.



Suitable Operating Temperature: 0°C~45°C. Do not place the machine near heat or fire

- When water storage level comes low, the pump would automatically stop. Please fill the tank to the maximum of the scale and do not over fill.
- 3 Do not stand, sit, or place thing on the fan. It may cause damage, overturning, or injury when things drop.
- 4 Keep the buckle of the ice cube entrance fasten after use.

- 5 Do not detach the cover guard and other parts of the fan, or it may cause fan damage or accident.
- Please provide an isolated socket or cable for the fan. Do not share the power source with other high power consumption equipment to ensure safety.
- By turn off the pump switch, you can use this product with only the fan function.

3 To ensure the best cooling effect, we suggest to wash the cooling pad and change the tank water once every week. Open the manual drain at the bottom, then fill the tank again after the following cleaning process can last the pump's service life longer.



A. Attention! Before the cleaning process, please switch off the fan, plug out, and move the fan away from power source and other equipment.



B. Open the manual drain below, and wash the cooling pad with soft brush from the top. After washing, wait until the waste water drain away, then close the drain.



C. When washing the cooling pad, do not spray water directly to the control panel or the cover of the inverter. This will damage the motor controller.



 D. Wipe the fan housing with wet towel, do not spray water or wipe it with volatile liquid.



Product damages cause by the following issues are not cover by our warranty.

- A. Power connect with incorrect voltage.
- B. Damage in handling or in transit caused by users.
- C. Damage caused by natural calamities.
- D. Structural damage caused by volatile liquid or gas.
- E. Accident or damage caused by wire connection or power sharing with other equipment.

- F. Damage caused by converting or changing of the parts.
- G. Malfunction caused by wire altering.
- H. Damage caused by water spray or rain.
- Pump damage caused by clogging due to careless of cleaning.


Feature and Manual



- Operation Process and Auto Water Inlet: Attach the quick connector of the water inlet hose to a faucet, and tighten it. Check and make sure the other end of the connector is fastened to the cooling fan. Open the faucet and fill the water tank to the highest level of the water storage scale. Turn on the power of pump (see Control Panel Instruction below), and let the water wet the cooling pad for 1-2 minutes, then turn on the power of fan and adjust the fan speed. By following the process, you will get the best cooling effect of your fan.
- Control Panel Instruction:



A		Power / Emergency Stop	Twist the button and light up the power indicator. Press the button to turn off the power when any emergency occur. Please follow the on and off process below for usual usage. Attention: Once you press the Emergency Stop, restart the fan after 20 second.
В		Power of Pump	Switch on the button, the pump will start as there is sufficient water inside the tank. The pump would not start when the water level is low. Please fill the tank before use.
C	0	Power of Fan	Switch on the power of fan and turn the fan speed regulator to control the speed.
D	0	Fan Speed Regulator	Control the fan speed as the power of fan is on. From 0-100; the higher the number, the faster the fan.
Œ)	•	Power of Shutters	Control the electric shutters of M902-COOL, M802-COOL, and M703-COOL.

• Inverter and controller of the fan is installed here. Wipe the fan with wet towel. Spraying water could caused electric leakage or short circuit.



 Water inlet pressure should not over 70 PSI.



 Manual drain. Open when changing and washing.


ATTENTION!

Before the cleaning process, please switch off the fan, plug out, and move the fan away from power source and equipment!



Change the Water Regularly

- Ouring use, the dust and particles would deposit inside the tank. This may lower the cooling capacity of the fan and brings bad odor. We suggest to change the water in the tank at least once a week; add more times if needed. And do not spray water directly to the inverter or control panel.
- The cooling fan can filter dust and particles. When using the fan in an area with bad air, we suggest to open the manual drain to let out the water after use. Fill the tank next time when needed.
- Manual Drain
 - Manual Drain: At the bottom of the cooling fan. Twist the knob to open and let out the water. Twist it
 back afterward.




The water cooling pads are consumables. Please contact us or our distributor for replacement when stained or torn.

UV-Light Cleaning Process

1 Before starting the process, please press the red button (Emergency Stop).



2 Unplug the power cord to avoid electric shock.







UV-Light Cleaning Process

After making sure the cooler is unplugged, please follow the guide below:

3 Open the ice cube entrance and unfasten the quick connector of the UV-light tube.




6 Take out the UV-light tube.



Find a container that can fit the tube. Soak the tube with white vinegar or citric acid solution.

After one hour, the limescale should be roughly removed. The required time will be varied by the thickness of the limescale.


(Suggested concentration of the solution: 1. One portion of white vinegar and 7 portions of water. 2. 5 grams of citric acid with 100 ml of water.)






UV-Light Cleaning Process

3 Rinse the light tube with water to wash the solution. Put the UV-light tube back to its cover by its original position.



Connect the quick connector properly and fasten it tight.



After installing the UV-light tube, close the ice cube entrance and finish the process.
